## Purpose of the Webinar

Food labeling and standards are prominent tools to protects consumer health, enhancing food safety, nutrition, and safeguard our environment. With the increasing global trade of food products, there is a growing need for reliable and trustworthy standards as well as guidance across food systems. This webinar will provide insights into how countries and international organizations collaborate to ensure that food lables and standards contribute to sustainable agrifood systems.
