## **Background**

The UN Food Systems Coordination Hub hosts virtual Food Systems Solutions Dialogues (FSSDs) as a collaborative platform for National Convenors and stakeholders to discuss and share practical solutions for sustainable food systems transformation. The FSSDs build on global commitments and outcomes of the 2021 UN Food Systems Summit, the 2023 UN Food Systems Summit +2 Stocktaking Moment, and the Secretary-General's Call to Action, empowering National Convenors to develop actionable strategies for implementing their national pathways.

The themes for the 2025 Food Systems Solutions Dialogues (2025 FSSDs) are aligned with the objectives of the forthcoming UN Food Systems Summit +4 Stocktake (UNFSS+4), scheduled in July 2025, focusing on **reflecting on progress**, **partnerships and tracking commitments**, and **unlocking finance and increasing investments** for food systems transformation. The 2025 FSSDs are designed to support governments in preparing their contributions to UNFSS+4 to document country progress at UNFSS+4 and beyond.

# **Purpose of this Dialogue**

Increasing global instability and the intersection of food systems and fragility present a critical challenge for sustainable development and human security. Fragile and conflict-affected states face unique, complex, and interconnected obstacles that hinder their ability to ensure lasting food security for their populations. This dialogue will delve into the emerging practices and innovative approaches employed to transform food systems in vulnerable settings. Positive examples of country-level transformation and investment planning from countries affected by fragility will be featured.
